KidTown

What is it?

KidTown is an exciting and **FREE** program run by Cub Scout Day Camp for the children of our camp volunteers. KidTown is a way for parents to volunteer for camp while at the same time providing a genuine camp experience for their other children. KidTown implements the same themes as the main camp and takes part in most of the regular activities of the rest of the camp, with the addition of circle time, hikes, crafts, games, songs and stories—in addition to taking part in the Friday Closing Ceremony!

Who can participate?

KidTown is open to children under 10 years old whose parents are volunteering that day. Children need to be able to use the bathroom without assistance. **Parents must be on the premises of the camp at all times.** KidTown is open during the entire camp day, and closes during lunchtime so families can eat together. Children must have a completed health history on file with the camp. Please note: boys registered with the BSA cannot take part in KidTown.

Who runs it?

KidTown is run by the Day Camp under the direction of the camp director. The area is integrated in many ways with the rest of the camp program. The KidTown Directors are qualified adults at least 21 years old, with assistants at least 18 years of age. In compliance with the camping standards of the Boy Scouts of America, at least two adults will be with the children at all times.
